Minutes of the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Monongahela, due notice of which meeting was published according to law, held Wednesday April 13, 2016 at 7 P.M. in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Kepics who led in the Pledge to the flag.

Public Forum:

Steve Seman, 218 West Main Street, owner of Hacker Shack Computers, asked council for their blessing in creating a website which would provide a database for the city's public records. After talking with a Donora councilman about this, he then acquired a domain name, moncity.us, for this purpose. Councilman Kulak said he agrees that the city is behind in getting the city information available to the public, but his issue is the question of liability when coming from an outside agency and he would prefer it on the city's own website. Councilman Caudill questioned the cost to the city and was told there would be no cost to the city. Mr. Seman was then told to contact the city clerk for scheduling purposes.

Chad DeSantis, Lawton Street, said he was present to support Mr. Seman and also reported there were only thirty-two facebook posts in one year and encouraged the city to use their social media.

Terry Necciai, Meade Street, informed council of the plans of the Post Office beginning to do a restoration project of the buildings windows.

Susan Bowers, 900 Lawrence Street, informed council she was contacted by Robin Young who was doing research in the state to erect plaques to honor women of history. The person to be honored in Monongahela is Jackie Ormes, the 1st African American Cartoonist in the United States. Ms. Young will be in Monongahela on April 30 to check the site for this historical marker which will be paid for by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission. Monongahela is needed to provide the site and install the marker. Councilman Caudill suggested Ms. Bowers form a committee along with Street Foreman Mark Gadd to choose the site.

Rusty Polonoli, Stockdale Avenue, announced the following events: May 14 is the annual fishing derby, May 14 is the annual Antique Appraisal sponsored by the MARC organization and the Dock Dogs at the Aquatorium is May 21 and 22.
