

CITY OF MONONGAHELA – EXCERPTED ORDINANCES CONCERNING  
LICENSING OF PLUMBERS AND ASSOCIATED FEES. (June, 2008)

B. Licensing of Plumbers

§411. License Required. No individual shall engage in the business of plumbing in the City of Monongahela, unless licensed as a master plumber under this provision of this Part. (Ord. 3-1978, 2/8/1978)

§412. Supervision of Work. No individual, firm, partnership or corporation shall engage in the business of installing, repairing or altering plumbing unless the plumbing work performed in the course of such business is under the direct supervision of a licensed master plumber. (Ord. 3-1978, 2/8/1978)

§417. Fees.

1. Any person desiring to be licensed as a master plumber, or as a journeyman plumber, shall make written application to the Board. Examination fees for master and journeyman plumber licenses shall be set from time to time by resolution of the City Council; payment of such fee to accompany the application. Examination fees are not returnable.
2. An annual license fee, to be set from time to time by resolution of the City Council, for master plumbers and journeyman plumbers shall also be paid to the office of the Code Enforcement Officer upon which payment a license shall be issued, such license to expire December 31 of the year in which issued.

NOTE: Current fee for master plumber license is fifty dollars. Current fee for journeyman plumber license is twenty dollars.

ALSO NOTE: If an individual already possesses a master or journeyman license in another city or municipality, he/she may present his/her current license to the Code Enforcement Officer at Monongahela City Hall to be immediately considered for a City Plumbers License.
