

**RESOLUTION NO. 21 OF 2020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON,  
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH  
THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON FOR THE COVID-19 RECOVERY MUNICIPAL  
GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, which is creating significant economic hardship for municipalities across Washington County, the Washington County Commissioners have allocated funds to support municipalities in recovering from, responding to, and preparing for coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monongahela has experienced significant expenditures as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of receiving economic support from Washington County, the City of Monongahela and the City of Monongahela Police Department will be required to enter into a "Coronavirus Relief Fund Recipient Agreement" with Washington County regarding the application for relief funds and the conditions of receipt thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monongahela resolves to enter into said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, at a duly called regular meeting of the City Council of Monongahela this 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2020 as follows:

1. The Mayor of the City of Monongahela and/or the Chief of Police of the City of Monongahela Police Department is authorized to and shall execute any and all documents necessary for participation in the Coronavirus Relief Fund program, shall act as its representative with respect to the program, and shall provide any additional information as may be required.


2. The Mayor of the City of Monongahela and/or the Chief of Police of the City of Monongahela Police Department directors shall submit to the Director of Budget and Finance all eligible expenditures related to the COVID-19 pandemic as soon as practicable. The Director of Budget and Finance shall work in conjunction with the Mayor and the Chief of Police to complete and submit the application and all other necessary documentation to Washington County as soon as possible.


3. This resolution shall be considered effective, retroactively, as of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020.
