CITY OF MONONGAHELA, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA EXPANDING THE DELCARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have declared a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) a "public health emergency of international concern," and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Secretary has declared COVID-19 to be a public health emergency in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020, Hon. Tom Wolf, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, declared a statewide disaster emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Board of Commissioners of Washington County, Pennsylvania declared a county-wide emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 Pa.C.S. § 11203(d), the Mayor of a Third Class City has the powers to declare a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, said declaration occurred on April 1, 2020, a copy of said Declaration being attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, due to the increase of cases and potential of exposure to the novel coronavirus in and around the County of Washington and the City of Monongahela, a state of emergency is existing and will continue to exist in the City of Monongahela and therefore should be expanded.

NOW, THEREFORE, at a duly called special meeting of the City Council of Monongahela held this 3rd day of April, 2020, it is hereby DECLARED AND RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Declaration of the State of Emergency, as attached and incorporated hereto as Exhibit A, is extended indefinitely until such time as a majority of the City Council suspends or terminates said state of emergency.
- 2. The Mayor is empowered to extend or revise the provisions of the Declaration during said time of the state of emergency.
