

RESOLUTION NO. 10 OF 2020

CITY OF MONONGAHELA, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA EXPANDING THE DELCARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have declared a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) a “public health emergency of international concern,” and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Secretary has declared COVID-19 to be a public health emergency in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020, Hon. Tom Wolf, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, declared a statewide disaster emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Board of Commissioners of Washington County, Pennsylvania declared a county-wide emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 Pa.C.S. § 11203(d), the Mayor of a Third Class City has the powers to declare a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, said declaration occurred on April 1, 2020, a copy of said Declaration being attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, due to the increase of cases and potential of exposure to the novel coronavirus in and around the County of Washington and the City of Monongahela, a state of emergency is existing and will continue to exist in the City of Monongahela and therefore should be expanded.

NOW, THEREFORE, at a duly called special meeting of the City Council of Monongahela held this 3rd day of April, 2020, it is hereby DECLARED AND RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Declaration of the State of Emergency, as attached and incorporated hereto as Exhibit A, is extended indefinitely until such time as a majority of the City Council suspends or terminates said state of emergency.
2. The Mayor is empowered to extend or revise the provisions of the Declaration during said time of the state of emergency.


Upon Motion of Ken Kulak, and second of Daryl Miller, this Resolution was approved by a vote of 5 Yeas 0 Nays.
