

Minutes for August 8, 2022 Work Session, gaveled into session at 8:30 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garry who led in the pledge to the Flag.


George Eckert informed council that the MARC's 5k race was held the prior weekend and thanked the police department, council, the Mayor and everyone else that participated and assisted with the event.
