

Minutes for June 6, 2022 Work Session, gaveled into session at 8:30 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garry who led in the pledge to the Flag.

Dave Barbe, Carroll Township, his son owns Fourth Street BBQ and Brewery in Charleroi that is too small and they are looking to expand so when the Frye property became available he purchased it and plans to put up a 15,000 square foot brewery and restaurant with an entertainment area. They are in the planning stages but are looking at over 3 million dollars to invest.

Mayor Garry stated that General Dave Papak with Laura Magone are having a Warriors Rock in Concert on July 3rd at the Aquatorium. It is a musical tribute concert starring veterans and was created as a community event.

He then stated he attended a prayer breakfast for Ringgold's class of 2022 and they gave him a banner that references God and asked if there was any objection to put it up in Council Chambers.

After discussion with council and the solicitor there was no objection to the banner being put up in council and should there be any protest from the public it would be removed.


