INTRODUCED November 9, 2022
ORDINANCE NO. - 2022
ADOPTED

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the council of the City of Monongahela, Washington, County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, the compensation payable to the several officers and employees of the City of Monongahela, Washington County, Pennsylvania, herein after named shall be, and the same is hereby fixed and designated for the year 2023.

SECTION I. That in the Department of Public Affairs:

(a) The Chief of Police shall receive a wage of \$34.97 per hour plus longevity for each hour he/she is actually engaged in the performance of their duties, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(a-1) The Chief of Police shall receive an additional days pay of \$279.77 plus longevity for fifteen (15) holidays listed below.

(a-2) Should the position of Chief of Police be vacated at any time, Section (a) and (a-1) shall become null and void, and the new Chief of Police shall receive a wage equal to an additional \$2.00 per hour over his/her current hourly wage at the time of appointment, and holiday pay shall be calculated based on the new Chief's hourly wage.

(b) Each Police Sergeant Detective Sergeant in existence at the time of adoption of this Ordinance shall receive a wage of 33.63 per hour plus longevity for each hour he/she is actually engaged in the performance of their duties, which shall be payable at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(b-1) Each Police Sergeant Detective in existence at the time of adoption of this Ordinance shall receive an additional days pay of \$269.04 plus longevity for fifteen (15) holidays listed below.

(b-2) Each Police Sergeant in existence at the time of adoption of this Ordinance shall receive a wage of \$33.38 per hour plus longevity for each hour he/she is actually engaged in the performance of their duties, which shall be payable at the time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(b-3) Each Police Sergeant in existence at the time of adoption of this Ordinance shall receive an additional days pay of \$267.04 plus longevity for fifteen (15) holidays listed below.

(b-4) Should any new Police Corporal, Sergeant, or Lieutenant be appointed during the year of 2023, said new appointment shall receive a wage equal to an additional \$0.25 per hour (Corporal), \$0.50 per hour (Sergeant), or \$1.00 per hour (Lieutenant) of his/her current hourly wage at the time of appointment, and holiday pay shall be calculated based upon the new appointment's hourly wage.

(c) Each Patrolman shall receive a wage of \$32.87 per hour plus longevity for each hour he/she is actually engaged in the performance of their duties, which shall be payable at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(c-1) Each Patrolman shall receive an additional days pay of \$62.96 plus longevity for fifteen (15) holidays listed below.

(d) Each new officer shall receive a starting salary of \$3,000.00 less than the base salary. Upon completion of State Police School, the salary shall be \$2,400.00 less than the base salary; at the end of the first year \$1,800.00 less than the base salary; at the end of eighteen months \$1,200.00 less than the base salary; at the end of two years \$600.00 less than the base salary; at the end of three years the base salary. All increases shall be based on the rookie's anniversary date and shall be paid effective on that date. All raises given the regular men during the three years of the rookie plan that raise the base salary or the longevity will raise the rookie in the same amount.

(d-1) Each Part-time Police Officer shall receive a beginning wage of \$22.16 per hour for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance of their duties, in accordance with the direction of the Mayor.

(e) Police Holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, President's Day, St. Patrick's Day, Good Friday, Easter, Memorial Day, Flag Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and employee's birthday.

(f) Each Police Officer eligible for longevity shall receive \$100.00 per year up to 28 years service.

(g) Each School Guard, employed by the City shall receive a wage of \$7.50 per hour for each hour she/he is actually engaged in the performance of her/his duties, in accordance with the direction of the Mayor.

(h) The Parking Revenue Officer and City Assistant shall receive a wage of \$20.32 per hour, which shall be payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable, in accordance with the direction of the Mayor.

(i) Extra help required by the Department of Public Affairs for painting such as streets, curbs and traffic lights, shall receive a wage of \$10.00 per hour for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance of their duties, in accordance with the direction of the Mayor.

SECTION II. That in the Department of Accounts and Finance:

(a) The City Clerk shall receive a salary of the sum of \$45,028.00 per annum, which shall be payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(b) The Office Assistant shall receive a salary of the sum of \$34,391.00 per annum, which shall be payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(c) The City Treasurer, as Treasurer of the City of Monongahela, shall receive a salary of the sum of \$2,000.00 per annum, payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(d) The City Treasurer, as Tax Collector, shall receive a salary of the sum of \$3,050.00 per annum, payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(e) The salary of the Deputy Tax Collector, employed by the City Treasurer, as Tax Collector, shall receive a salary of the sum of \$27,857.00 per annum, which shall be payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

SECTION III. That in the Department of Public Safety:

(a) The Chief of the Fire Department shall receive a wage of the sum of \$6,000.00 per annum, which shall be payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(b) The Caretaker of the fire trucks and fire equipment shall receive a salary of the sum of \$5,000.00 per annum payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(c) Laborers required by the Fire Department and Health Department shall receive a wage of \$7.50 per hour for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance of their duties under the direction of the Director of Public Safety.

(d) The Health Officer shall receive a salary of \$2,500.00 per annum, which shall be payable in equal portions monthly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable under the direction of the Director of Public Safety.

(e) The Secretary of the Board of Health shall receive a salary of the sum of \$600.00 per annum, which shall be payable in equal portions biweekly, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(f) The Rental Inspector shall receive a salary of the sum of \$47,754.00 per annum, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(g) The Code Enforcement Officer shall receive a wage of \$20.00 per hour for each hour he/she is actually engaged in the performance of his/her duties, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

SECTION IV. That in the Department of Streets and Improvements:

(a) The Street Foreman shall receive a wage of \$34.40 per hour for each hour he/she is actually engaged in the performance of his/her duties, at the same time as the payroll for such period is payable.

(b) The Equipment Operators required by the Street Department shall receive a wage of \$28.00 per hour for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance of their duties, under the direction of the Street Foreman.

(c) The Full-Time Laborers required by the Street Department shall receive a wage of \$27.26 per hour for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance of their duties, under the direction of the Street Foreman.

(d) The Part-Times Laborers required by the Street Department shall receive a wage of \$18.00 per hour for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance of their duties, under the direction of the Street Foreman.

SECTION V. That in the Department of Parks & Property:

(a) The Laborers required by the Department of Parks & Property shall receive a wage of \$15.00 per hour, for each hour they are actually engaged in the performance, of their duties, under the direction of the Director of Parks & Property.

SECTION VII. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as the provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION VIII. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2023.
